The Proposal will be received at the office of the Firebaugh Canal Water District, 2412 Dos Palos Road, Mendota, CA 93640 (mailed proposals should be addressed the PO Box) prior to 2:00 p.m. on October 29, 2026 for the following work:

3rd LIFT CANAL MODERNIZATION PROJECT – FAIRFAX TO BRANNON

The work includes the installation of concrete lining on approximately 2 miles of the 3rd Lift Canal, including 21,800 cubic yards (CY) of compacted embankment, pre-cast turnout structures, and appurtenances; the construction of new reservoir on approximately 14 acres, including 35,000 CY of compacted embankment, placement of 74,600 square feet of rip rap, security fencing and a reinforced concrete spill structure; The construction of a new pump station, including 67 cubic yards of reinforced concrete, 15", 18" and 24" pipelines, pump manifolds, electrical conduit and electrical control security enclosure.

There will be a mandatory job showing at 1:30 pm on October 7th, 2026 beginning at Fairfax Avenue and the 3rd Lift Canal. Attendance at this job showing is required to bid the project.

The Project is a Public Works project and compliance with State and Federal wage laws

(including Davis-Bacon) are required.

The Contractor will be required to furnish a performance bond in an amount equal to one hundred percent (100%) of the contract price and a labor and materials bond in an amount equal to one hundred percent (100%) of the contract price, said bonds to be secured from a financially responsible surety company, satisfactory to the District, authorized to do business in the State of California.

The Contractor may substitute securities for any moneys withheld to insure performance under the contract in strict accordance with Section 22300 and 10263 of the Public Contracts Code of the State of California.

The Proposal submitted in response to this invitation shall include the cost of all work, labor and materials to complete the project. It shall, furthermore, include all materials and labor of whatever kind required in regard to providing adequate sheeting, shoring and bracing of excavations.
